La Torretta takes the always popular and enjoyable Moscato to the frizzante side – the hint of carbonation adds a splash of fun to a wine that is already fragrant and fruity with hints of citrus. Soft golden yellow with straw reflections.

## VARIETAL NOTES

The Muscat grape is so widely planted that it is said to be the world's oldest cultivated grape. The versatile grape can be colored from white to nearly black. It is known for its perfumed floral aroma and pronounced sweetness on the palate.

## FOOD PAIRING

Perfect with dry pastries, hazelnut cake, or Christmas desserts like panettone. Serve chilled at 42-44 degrees F.
